LEGITIMATE INTEREST ASSESSMENT

Lawful basis for processing data

This document sets out the lawful basis for processing personal data supplied to us by our customers we have established for BGC Holdings Ltd, and all subsidiaries and associated companies (hereinafter referred to as the 'Company').

Purpose Test

The Company processes the name, company and contact details, including telephone and email address of those people who enter their details on our website.

We ask for this so that we can understand what their enquiry is for our services as an industrial door manufacturer and servicer.

We do not need, or ask for, any more personal information than this. We never ask for any sensitive personal data as defined by the General Data Protection Regulation 2016.

The purpose of requesting the data that we ask for is to provide a business to business service related to what we do as a company.

Necessity Test

Without the above process the Company would not be able to obtain requests for our products and services.

The information requested is the minimum we believe to enable us to contact prospective customers and for them to understand what they are asking for by reference to our website.

Balancing Test

Because we are only asking for a limited amount of personal data to be used on a business to business basis, we do not believe we are asking for excessive personal or sensitive data.

Any data breach is likely to result in a low level of exposure of personal data and would only cause the data subject minimal material damage.

Considering the above we consider that positive impact of our processing the personal data provides a legitimate interest which overrides the risk of any negative impact.
